We ask all of our members to write to your Federal Representatives in the area that you reside and ask for their support H.R. 711 the WEP bill.

Dear \_\_\_\_\_:

I call on you for your support of H.R. 711, which would replace a portion of the Social Security Act with a new version of the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP). The current version of the WEP unjustly deprives many Ohio public safety officers (and other public servants) of their fully earned benefits. Please make passage of the H.R. 711 an urgent priority.

H.R. 711 would replace the WEP with a new and fair formula that treats public employees the same as other workers in America. It guarantees that our police officers and firefighters receive the benefits they earned while working another job and paying into Social Security. Provisions in H.R. 711 will provide benefits to all workers who have earned them *without adversely* affecting the Social Security Trust Fund. Congress should be helping retired public servants, not authorizing the Social Security Administration to penalize them for their dedicated service.

The bill was introduced by Rep. Kevin Brady (R, Texas) and co-sponsored by Rep. Richard Neal (D, Massachusetts). I ask you to join as a co-sponsor of this legislation if you have not already, to help build momentum for its passage. I will be following the progress of this legislation and your actions to achieve the long-overdue repeal of the WEP.
