Updates from OP&F Pension Fund

More options now available for retirement interviews

OP&F continues to ease the restrictions that were necessary during the pandemic, including the resumption of in-person retirement interviews at our headquarters in downtown Columbus.

While our members education area is conducting a limited amount of interviews, virtual retirement meetings have become a popular option. An OP&F staff member can connect with a member and their spouse with their smart phone, tablet or computer.

OP&F has developed brief video instructions on how to access a video conference. These videos are available at the Plan for your Retirement page on the OP&F website. A link to these videos is also included in the email sent to members confirming the appointment.

OP&F going paperless for monthly benefit statements

Beginning this summer, OP&F will no longer mail benefit statements to retirees when their benefit amount changes. Instead, an email will be sent alerting the member that a new monthly statement is available in the secure member area of the OP&F website. Besides saving money, this method protects members' personal information.

The new process will begin with an email in late July alerting those members with a benefit change that their August 2021 statement is available online to view, download or print. No personal member information will be included in the email, just a link to log onto the secure Member Self-Serve portal at op-f.org.

Retirees who prefer it can call OP&F and request that a statement be mailed.

Newsletter distribution

During the May 26th OP&F Board of Trustees meeting there was a question about who receives the quarterly Member's Report newsletter. It is our goal to send this publication to all OP&F members via U.S. mail, including active members, retirees and survivors. For the spring 2021 newsletter, the mailing list included 60,515 names, plus an additional 200 names of interested parties that are not OP&F members (these include legislators and bargaining units, among others).
